EVENT DETAILS

- \$250 per player for members, \$350 for non-members of HPIB (Includes: 4 games, jersey, socks, welcome bag, HPIB tournament party Saturday night, networking, food and drink)
- Limited to 120 skaters and 8 goalies (8 teams)
- 4 game guarantee per team (1 Friday, 2 Saturday, and 1 Sunday - 20 minute periods, 3 minute warm-up, referees, and game music)
- Skill-Level Based Scoring system to encourage teamwork – 1 point for an A player, 2 points for a B player and 3 points for a C player. 3 goal max per game for all players.
